Room duties Again, this depends on the room, but you can at least expect to attend room rounds and complete tasks such as requesting reports, tests, or blood tests. You will find that sometimes when you need to refer a patient or submit one at a round of the board, and someone may ask you to "score" the signs and symptoms accordingly. There is a slight variation of NEWS for Obstetrics (OEWs) and Pediatrics (PEWS): Your hospital will have a proforma to follow that you must complete in its entirety, writing down pertinent information such as the patient's current complaints, medical history, medications, test results, etc. and what you think the differences might be along with your treatment plan. If you are covered in the room, you may have a beep to check on a seriously ill patient, drink fluids, prescribe more medicines, or hoax or catheterize a patient. It's something you'll use regularly when you need to prescribe treatment or check for interactions.The SIGN Guidelines is for any of you in Scotland, and most importantly, the Induction app for all your first day needs. It's up to you whether you want to start in a FY1 position without training, but I would recommend targeting more FY2 positions at the NHS as the responsibilities differ very slightly, but there is a salary increase associated with being a junior physician at the FY2 level. There is no harm in applying for CT1/ST1 level positions as your first job if you feel you are up to the task. There is often a policy of confidence regarding what type of medicine is used in any situation that has arisen, so don't be shy to check the hospital's intranet and find the right path for the patient you are seeing. Do you still have worries? Check out our post on how to prepare for ALS if you'll be taking it soon, or how to approach audits/QIPs so you can get started on your portfolio as soon as possible. It consists of delivering to patients that Á seen, either during the night or during the on-call day. That's it. I like to carry with me a small notebook (I use mops, so it's small and fits in my mop pocket) where I list how to do certain things that I might forget after just learning it once, so that next time I have a reference source. As a doctor on call, you are not expected to attend to each and every patient; rather, your job is to continue or complete any outstanding tasks of the day's team, or follow up on any seriously ill patient. This means taking breaks every 4 hours, delivering when appropriate, and knowing when to step back when things are too much for you to handle. Whether for on-call service or on-call service, you will be given a beep or pager on which will be an extension number on which you can contact.
